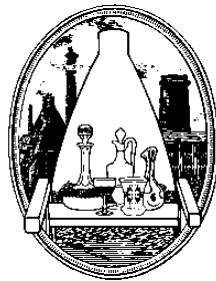

## 20<sup>th</sup> Century Glass 'Art Deco to Mid-Century Modern'
